

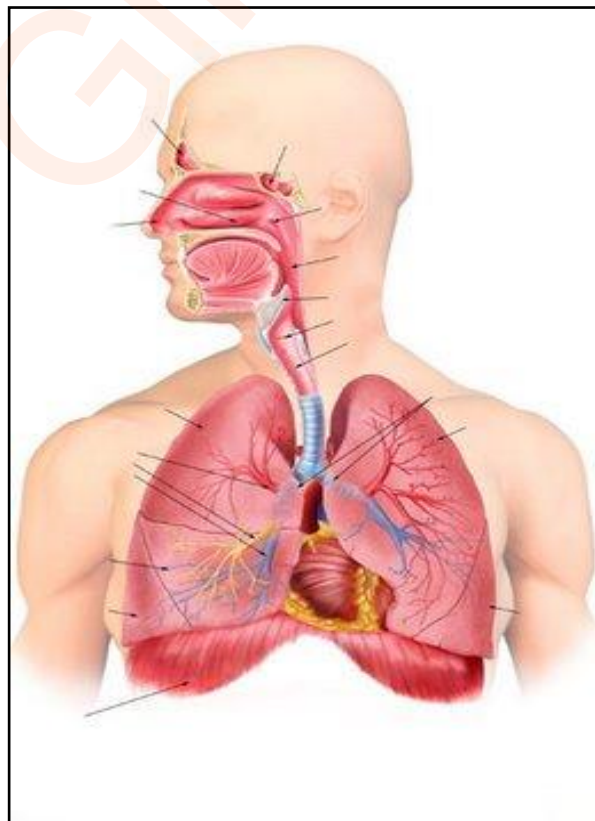

► THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

We use our **respiratory system** to **breathe** in air. Our body needs **oxygen** from the air in order to survive.

- When we breathe in, air enters our body through our **nose** and **mouth**.
- The air goes down the **trachea**.
- Next, it goes through two small tubes called the bronchi, and enters our **lungs**.
- In our lungs, oxygen passes from the air into our **blood**.
- Finally, **carbon dioxide** from our body returns to the lungs. When we breathe out, it leaves our body.

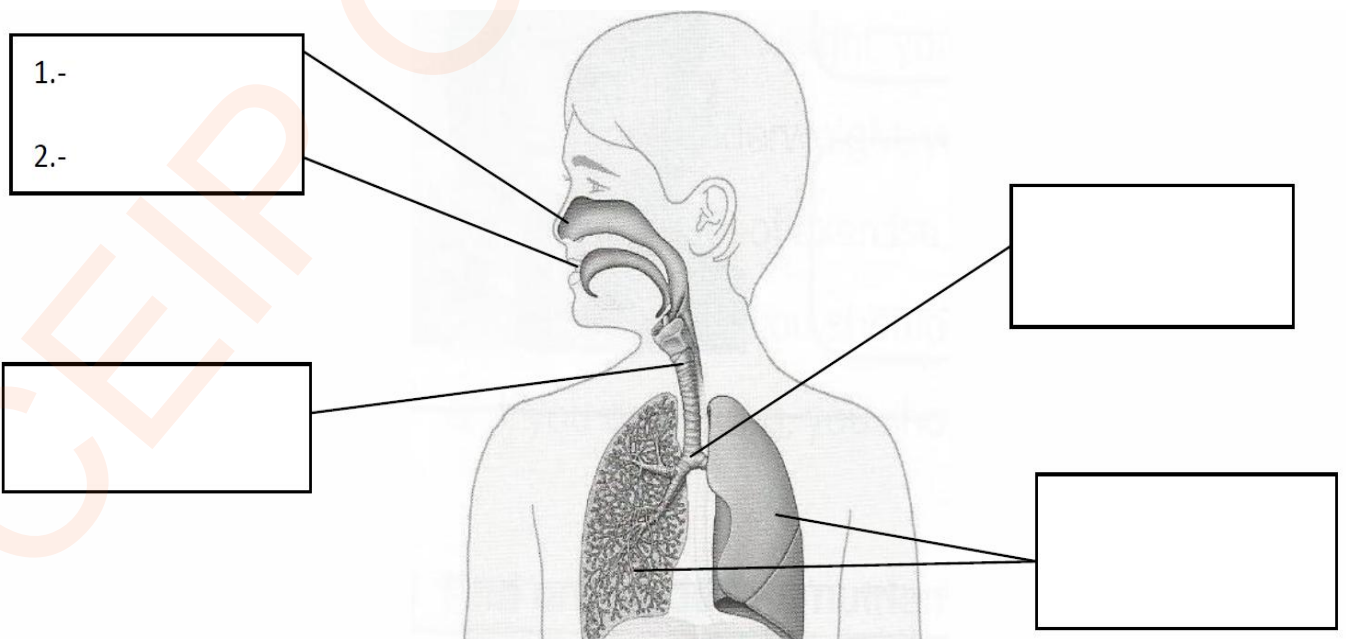
