The most important monuments are the Eiffel Tower, the Notre Dame Cathedral, and the Arc de Triomphe in Paris. The Loire is the longest river in France. It is around 1,013 km long. Another important river is the Seine. Mont Blanc is the highest mountain in France. Its elevation is 4,810 m above sea level.
