OF THE RESEARCH FELLOWS

Research

- Fulfil the period of stay so as to accomplish the object of recruitment.
- Incorporation into the host center on the date set and perform the research activity in accordance with standards laid down in this Call.

Facilitate reporting

Be available to the Andalusian Knowledge System, the host institution and the Andalusian knowledge system agent acting as contracting entity to facilitate reporting to competent supervisory bodies, both national and at EU level.

Documents, visa and authorizations

Manage documents, visas and authorizations necessary to enter the country of destination and to reside there under applicable law for the duration of the research process.

Working relationship

Establish a working relationship with the beneficiaries in accordance with the provisions of the regulations.

Fellowship management and justification

- Pass the funds received to the beneficiaries according to the regulations.
- Justify the payment of the funds received to the grant awarding body.
- Submit the justifications submitted by fellows to the grant awarding body.

Policies, principles and ethics

- Commit to the principles of the European Charter for Researchers and The Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers.
- In line with the rationale and principles of the People Program within the FP7, the Research Project will be approved by an ethical review board when starting and ending the research project. The ethical review board will verify that the Project complies with their destination's national and regional regulations regarding ethics, as well as with the limitations imposed by the ethical rules applying to the EU's Seventh Framework Programme for Research.

Others obligations

- Collaborate in the procedure of refund when the case is given according to Title II of Law 38/2003 of November 17, notwithstanding what is provided in Law 30/1992 of November 26.
- Adhere to all monitoring and control of the Research Project by the Andalusian Knowledge Agency and the European Union as well any other competent supervisory body.
- Reinstate the funds in case of breach of requirements and obligations of the fellowship scheme and, in any case, regulated in article 37 of Law 38/2003 of November 17, General Subsidies Law, as grounds for refund.
