Sydney

Sydney is a city on the east coast of Australia. Sydney is the capital city of New South Wales. About four million people live in Sydney and it is the biggest city in Australia. Sydney started in 1788, when the Captain Arthur Phillip **brought** the first **settlers** in Australia. They were convicts from **crowded** prisons in England and Ireland, with a group of soldiers to guard them.

In Sydney, there are many famous buildings: the Sydney Opera House, the Queen Victoria Building and the Sydney Harbour Bridge. Sydney has a large **harbour** and many beaches. The most famous beach is Bondi Beach, some other famous beaches are Coogee Beach and Manly Beach. Famous parts of the harbour are Darling Harbour and Circular Quay.

Sydney has many things to see and do. People can visit Taronga Zoo (a park for animals) on the northern side of the harbour, eat food, look at art or watch sports (like cricket or rugby) or walk down George Street with its nice shops.
