Other Site Characteristics

La zona donde se encuentran las ZEC Ríos Cuzna y Gato está formada por batolitos graníticos y materiales paleozoicos plegados durante la orogenia hercínica. El cauce del río Cuzna tiene una anchura media de 3 m y una pendiente media lateral izquierda de 5º a 15º y derecha de 35º a 40º. Respecto al río Gato, presenta una pendiente longitudinal de 0,2% a 1,5% y una pendiente transversal, tanto en el tramo derecho como izquierdo, mayor del 10%. Esta ZEC se sitúa en la subcuenca del Guadalmellato. El lugar queda encuadrado principalmente en la categoría paisajística Serranías, dentro del área paisajística Serranías de baja montaña.La vegetación potencial de la ZEC Río Cuzna y Gato se corresponde con la serie EH7: geoserie edafohigrófila meso-termomediterránea mediterráneo-iberoatlántica silicícola. Debido a los procesos de degradación qua ha ido sufriendo la vegetación de ribera, de acuerdo con la información facilitada por el CEDEX, en la primera banda de la ZEC Ríos Cuzna y Gato se encuentra una tesela heterogénea con tramos que mantienen fresnedas fragmentarias, o restos de ellas, y otros dominados por tamujar con adelfas y fresnos, a menudo formando mosaicos. Estas fresnedas son notables por la abundancia de Phillyrea media arbóreas y de Bupleurum fruticosum. Además, por observaciones de campo y aportaciones del personal técnico vinculado a la gestión de estos espacios se tienen indicios de la presencia en la ZEC Ríos Cuzna y Gato de otros dos HIC, 3260. Ríos de pisos de planicie a montano con vegetación de Ranunculion fluitantis y de Callitricho-Batrachion y 92A0. Bosques galería de Salix alba y Populus alba.

4.2 Quality and importance

Presenta un cauce de río y vegetación riparia bien conservado que favorece los hábitats y especies caracteríscas de este ecosistema fluvial, entre ellas especies endémicas de la península ibérica.
