Other Site Characteristics

Se trata de un espacio fronterizo con Portugal, formado por los cursos bajos de dos ríos, el Guadiana y el Chanza (afluente éste del primero). En la desembocadura en el Océano Atlántico, el río Guadiana forma un estuario de orillas pantanosas.

4.2 Quality and importance

Este espacio es importante por la función conectora que desempeña. Es el eje vertebrador del complejo de espacios protegidos red Natura 2000 presente alrededor de la frontera hispano-lusa, conectando el extremo occidental de Sierra Morena, a través de todo el territorio conocido como la Faja Píritica, con el Océano Atlántico. El mantenimiento en un estado de conservación favorable de este ecosistema fluvial resulta esencial para la conservación de un gran número de especies de peces de la Directiva 92/43/CEE. Se incluyen especies que están dentro de la Lista Roja de la Flora Vascular de Andalucía: Carex acuta, Juniperus phoenicea subsp. turbinata, Limonium algarvense y Spartina maritima.
